Since, we have lived an experience without precedence in our small town of Palacaguina; 200 kilometers (125 miles) north of the capital. Always from Nicaragua, we are hoping that little by little things can improve, however it seems that we must learn to live with this new reality.

Despite all this, at PCA we feel blessed because with all the tragedies, mourning, pain and suffering, God has protected us. At PCA we have not had a major impact, we thank God that he is protecting our students, parents, and workers. We pray that doors continue to open for PCA, to protect and bless each of the sponsors of this beautiful school, we know that without the help of the sponsors this would be very difficult to achieve. Thank God for our sponsors. In our new role, by God's grace, we have learned to live with new rules of hygiene, safety and social distancing.

PCA's NEW SIDEWALK

It is such a blessing to see how the staff and parents of PCA, each year, are taking more ownership of their school. Nearly every day during the rainy season, teachers, parents, and our students must walk through mud in order to come to school. A sidewalk would make such a huge difference, however, with so many projects and needs, it has continued to be at the bottom of the priority list. I am so proud of our teachers who decided to take action. Raising the money to get started, they initiated the construction of sidewalks in front of PCA. The parents of PCA gladly participated and helped finish the project. Raising more than \$750 locally, they were able to build new sidewalks for the school. That is so much money to our families and it demonstrates the pride and commitment they have to investing in the futures of their children. Way to go PCA!!



2021 PROJECT FOCUS AND GOALS

2021 PCA Projects, by importance, include:

- Construction of our 5th/6th grade classroom building (\$32,470)
 - Phase I: Excavation/Foundation/1st Level Walls \$9,960 MET
 - Phase II: 1st Level Roof/Windows/Tile/Finishing \$10,470 MET
 - Phase III: 2nd Level Walls/Roof/Railing \$6,350 MET
- Moving perimeter fence and build retaining wall for 5th grade expansion \$6,500 MET
 - Building front sidewalk \$1,250 MET
 - Leveling tractor work for Cancha (Gym) \$3,000
 - Prepare/Equip the 4-6th grade play area \$1,000
 - New gate needed at East entrance to the primary school \$1,000

NEXT PROJECTS (2022)

- ► 5th/6th Phase IV: 2nd Level Windows/Tile/Doors/Finishing \$5,690 (\$3,000 MET)
 - Build roof/floor to complete the cafeteria area gap \$2,500
 - Paint primary school \$1,500
 - Expand roofing over 4-6th grade play are \$6,300 We look forward to sharing more details about these projects as they begin.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- Please continue to pray for God to open doors for sponsorship of our students and the completion of our important construction projects needed to finish building the school.
- Pray for wisdom as we approach our hiring season for next year. Pray the Lord will bring the right people our way as we hire an additional teacher and support staff.

PCA SPONSORSHIP

We have 60 students unsponsored at PCA. We strive to never turn a child away due to not having a sponsor,



but the budget challenges for having many students unsponsored are difficult. Consider sharing the opportunity to sponsor one of our students with friends or family.
