Each year we grow and mature as a school and ministry. This last month we took one more step in our maturity with official signage at the school. Though it may seem like a small thing, to us it is one more indicator of the impact we are making as we continue to lead the way in formally establishing a school that is building into the next generation. We believe and hope to make a difference in the lives of many future generations of children in Palacagüina.



BOMBEROS (FIREFIGHTERS)

Palacagüina has a new fire department and we have been enjoying building a wonderful partnership with the fire fighters. This month, they have spent time with our students in class, brought the fire truck on campus for the kids to experience, helped us install our new water tank, provided water for the school, and helped remove a dead tree posing a risk to the students. We are grateful for the relationships being built and how God will use them to bless our students and build more local partnerships. They are our highlight this month.



Many of the full-time firefighters do not receive a regular salary but are more like full-time volunteers. They survive only on small donations from the city. Please pray that one day we can help with the needs of the fire department and increase our positive impact on the city of Palacagüina.



NEW WATER TANK

In March, we realized an urgent need at PCA as our existing water tank failed and left our campus with no water. With a temporary patch and the help of our local fire department we were able to limp along, but the urgency to replace our tank and repair the damaged water system was immediate. The new water tank has been installed and we are close to having this project complete. Thank you to the many who responded to this need. The new tank and water project are fully funded!

PCA WATER SHORTAGE

This year, the city of Palacagüina has been impacted by drought due to high temperatures and lack of rain causing water rationing to be necessary. With the recent addition of our kitchen cafeteria and the growth of our student body, the water needs of PCA have increased tremendously. Our new water tank, which is much larger, will help resolve this, but over the last month we found our existing, half-patched system only provided enough water for 2 days. Four times this month, we coordinated with the local fire department to provide the school water by filling up our tank. Though this comes at an additional cost, we are grateful for the fire department and their willingness to assist the school in this need.

2022 PCA Projects, by importance, include:

- Replace PCA Water Tank System \$1,650 FULLY FUNDED
- Finish 6th grade classroom \$6,450
 - Phase I: Windows/Doors \$3,200 FULLY FUNDED
 - Phase II: Tile/Finishing \$2,600 FULLY FUNDED
 - Phase III: Desks \$2,150 (\$500 Raised)
- Paint primary school \$2,000 FULLY FUNDED
- Finish back wall \$3,000
- Multi-Purpose Center (MPC) (Cancha) Possibly up to \$90K
 - Phase I: Front Foundation \$4,000
 - Phase II: Concrete Floor \$TBD
- ➤ 2nd Level Sewing Space/Mission Housing \$10,000
- Expand roofing over 4th-6th grade play area \$6,300

PRAYER REQUESTS


- Pray for Bailey as she battles spiritual and physical attacks against her health.
